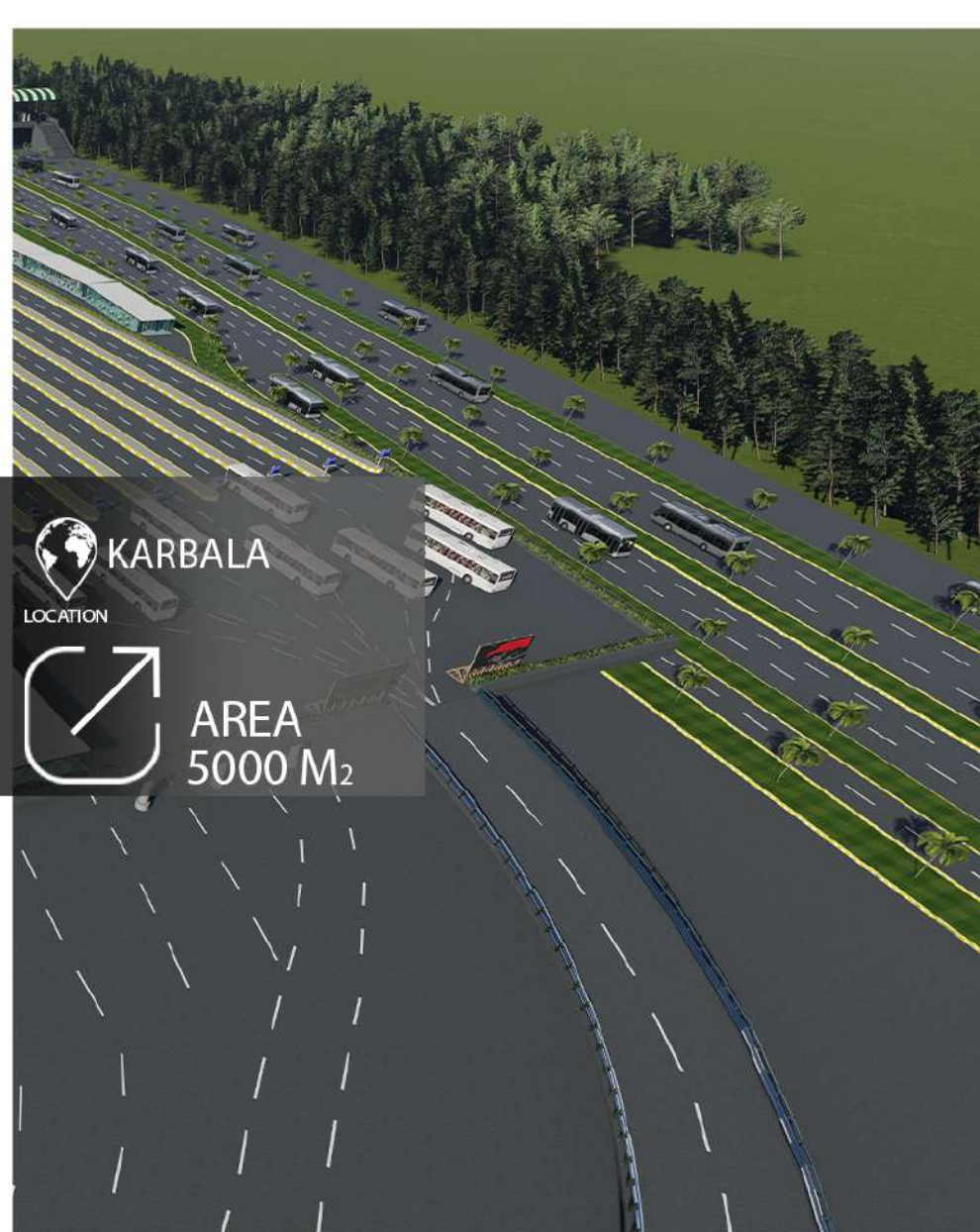
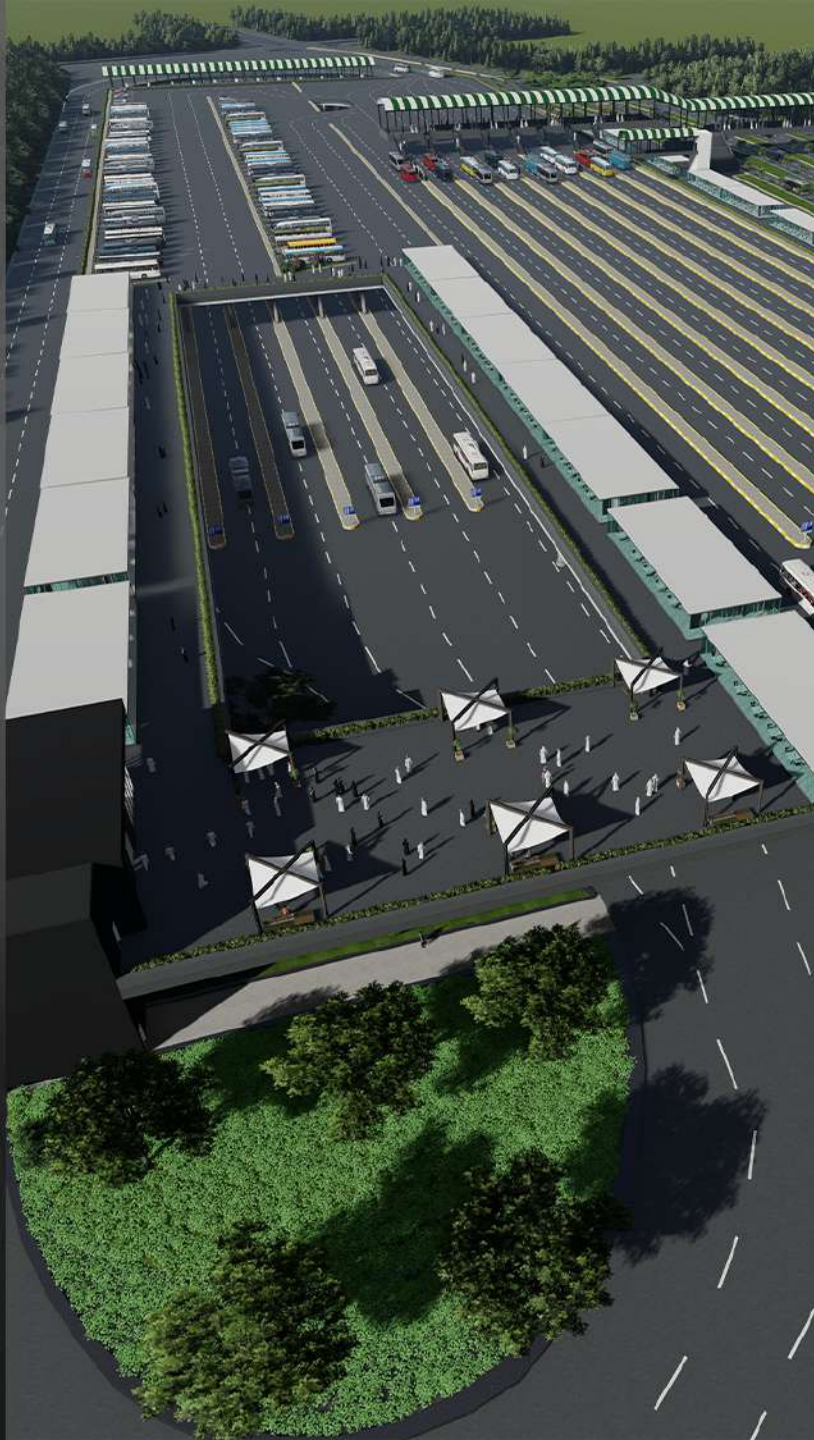


ABOUT PROJECT

The Fariha Project is one of the largest proposed designs for temporary terminals serving pilgrims traveling to Karbala. Covering an area of approximately 35,000 SQ meters, this terminal aims to provide a well-organized, safe, and efficient space to manage the massive influx of pilgrims during special occasions, particularly Arbaeen. The design of Fariha emphasizes smooth pedestrian flow, accessible service points, proper ventilation, and convenient connection to public transportation. One of its key features is the use of lightweight, modular, and easy-to-assemble structures, making it ideal for rapid construction and short-term operation.

In contrast, the jawdeh Project, with an area of around 5,000 SQ meters is a smaller-scale temporary terminal designed for locations with lower pilgrim density or limited space. This project follows a minimal yet functional approach, aiming to deliver maximum service efficiency within a compact footprint. Its modular layout, flexibility in interior arrangement, and quick installation capacity make jawdeh a practical solution for various temporary needs along pilgrimage routes. The project highlights the potential of smart, resource-conscious design in providing effective services to pilgrims even under spatial and logistical constraints .
